What is the Linton-Poodry SACNAS Leadership Institute (LPSLI)?

The Linton-Poodry SACNAS Leadership Institute (LPSLI) provides premiere training to motivated STEM professionals across academic, industry, nonprofit, and government sectors, geared toward advancing diversity, equity, and inclusion.

This five-day, experiential training will help participants explore topics such as:

- Emotional Intelligence
- Implicit Bias
- Leadership Development Planning

In addition to career-stretching insights through a 360-degree assessment, mentorship, and networking with peers nationwide, participants will graduate into a cohort of over 300 LPSLI alumni.

Where is the training?
