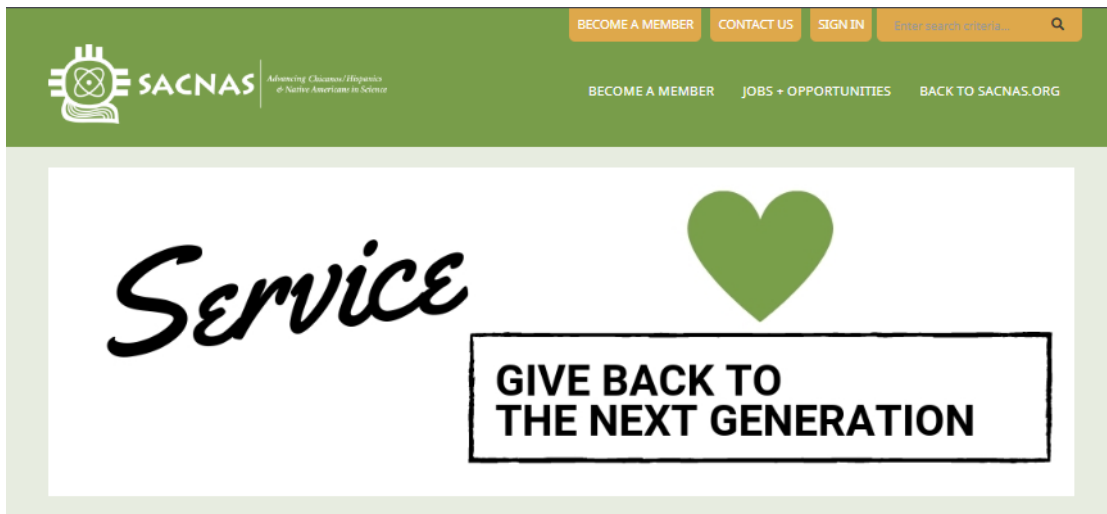


How to Access Membership & Applications

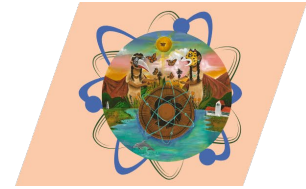

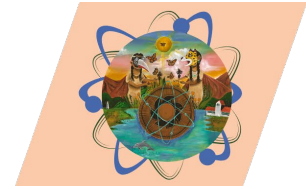

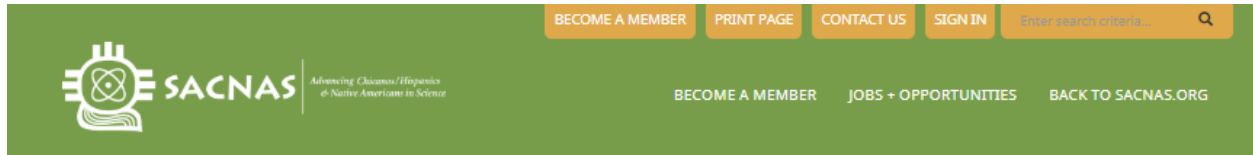

RESEARCH PRESENTATIONS - Apply by April 17, 5pm PT

SPRING-ONLY! Applicant must be one of the following at the time of submission:

- Undergraduate and post baccalaureate students can apply for a poster presentation
- Graduate students can apply for a poster or oral presentation (choose one within application)
- Post-doctoral researchers can apply for an oral presentation

NOTE: The summer application period will ONLY be open to undergraduate students in a summer research program

TRAVEL SCHOLARSHIPS - Apply by April 17, 5pm PT

SPRING-ONLY! Applicant must be one of the following, during fall 2020:

- Undergraduate student interested in pursuing a master's or PhD in a STEM field and enrolled in a two-year or four-year college/university
- Graduate student interested in pursuing a PhD in STEM and enrolled in a masters or doctorate program

NOTE: The summer application period will ONLY be open to undergraduate students in a summer research program
